COL Geoffrey Ling, MC, is a program manager at the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency whose portfolio includes Revolutionizing Prosthetics, Fracture Putty, Preventing Violent Explosive Neurologic Trauma (PREVENT), Restoring Plasticity and Acceleration of Injury Recovery (REPAIR), and Predicting Health and Disease (PHD). COL Ling is also professor and interim chairman of neurology at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences in Bethesda, Md; director of neurocritical care at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center; and attending neurocritical care physician at Johns Hopkins Hospital. He deployed to Afghanistan and Iraq and served as a member of the Gray Team for the Joint Chiefs of Staff.
